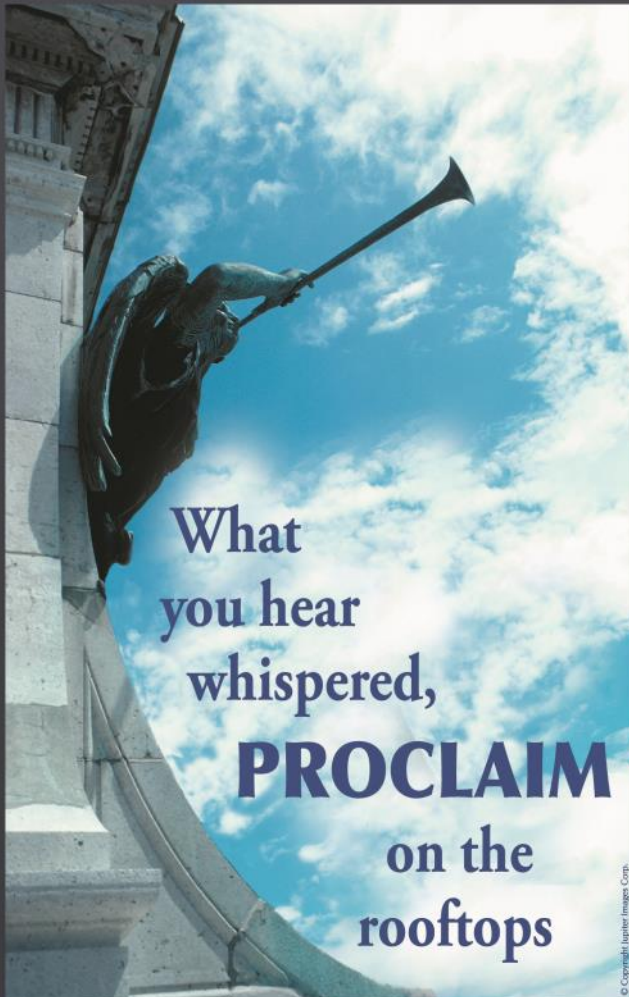

Gospel Reflection

A report published in an online daily speaks of the courage and conviction of the victims of horrible persecution in Syria: “Some were praying in the name of Jesus; some were praying the Lord’s Prayer; some of them lifted their heads to commend their spirits to Jesus. One of the women looked up and seemed to be almost smiling as she said, “Jesus!” In today’s Gospel, Jesus says “Everyone...who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven.” Jeremiah the prophet of God, was subjected to all sorts of mental and physical torture, yet he remained faithful to Yahweh and the mission entrusted to him. Jesus reassured his own disciples of the fact that nothing would happen to any of them without his knowledge and purpose.

Each of his disciples is precious to Jesus. Those who attack and torture them can only destroy their body, which is anyway destined to decay, but they can not destroy their soul, which is made for eternity. Therefore, for a disciple of Jesus Christ, there is no need to fear or run away in the face of persecution. Our heavenly Father is the author of life and he would not abandon any of his children.

Today’s Readings

I hear the whisperings of many: “Terror on every side! Denounce! let us denounce him!” All those who were my friends are on the watch for any misstep of mine. “Perhaps he will be trapped; then we can prevail, and take our vengeance on him.” But the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph. In their failure they will be put to utter shame, to lasting, unforgettable confusion. O Lord of hosts, you test the just, you see mind and heart, Let me witness the vengeance you take on them, for to you I have entrusted my cause. Sing to the Lord, praise the Lord, For he has rescued the life of the poor from the power of the wicked!

But death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who did not sin after the pattern of the trespass of Adam, who is the type of the one who was to come.

GOSPEL (Mathew 10:26-33)

Jesus said to the Twelve: “Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops. And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father’s knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So, do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father.”

A Fathers Day Prayers

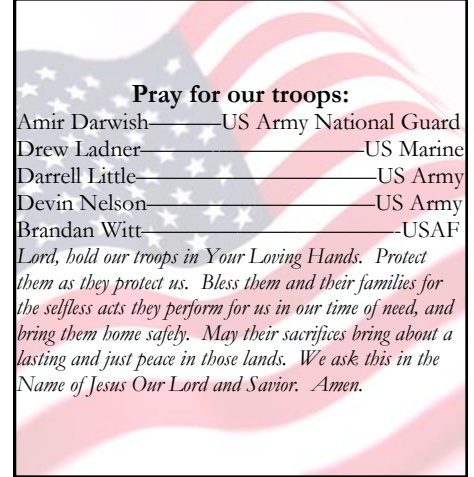
