TODAY'S READING'S

Reading I 2 Kings 5:14-17

Naaman went down and plunged into the Jordan seven times at the word of Elisha, the man of God. His flesh became again like the flesh of a little child, and he was clean of his leprosy. Naaman returned with his whole retinue to the man of God. On his arrival he stood before Elisha and said, "Now I know that there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel. Please accept a gift from your servant." Elisha replied, "As the LORD lives whom I serve, I will not take it;" and despite Naaman's urging, he still refused. Naaman said: "If you will not accept, please let me, your servant, have two muleloads of earth, for I will no longer offer holocaust or sacrifice to any other god except to the LORD."

Reading II 2 Timothy 2:8-13

Beloved: Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David: such is my gospel, for which I am suffering, even to the point of chains, like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore, I bear with everything for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, together with eternal glory. This saying is trustworthy: If we have died with him we shall also live with him; if we persevere we shall also reign with him. But if we deny him he will deny us. If we are unfaithful he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself.

Gospel Luke 17:11-19

As Jesus continued his journey to Jerusalem, he traveled through Samaria and Galilee. As he was entering a village, ten lepers met him. They stood at a distance from him and raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" And when he saw them, he said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." As they were going they were cleansed. And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him. He was a Samaritan. Jesus said in reply, "Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?" Then he said to him, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you."

ALL SOULS DAY November 2nd

In the Catholic Church, praying for the dead is a significant practice rooted in the belief that prayers can aid the souls of the deceased in their journey toward heaven. This practice is closely connected to the doctrine of 'Purgatory' where souls that are not yet purified but are destined for heaven.

Masses for the dead: offering Mass for the deceased is considered one of the most powerful forms of prayers. The Eucharist celebration is believed to be particularly effective in helping the souls in purgatory.

All Souls Day: November 2nd is a special day in the Catholic Church liturgical calendar dedicated to praying for all the faithful departed. So those of you who wish to offer Masses for your loved ones you may use the envelopes bearing the names of your loved ones with the offering or donation which will be used for the vocation promotion for the priesthood.

The family of Annunciation parish is going to remember the loved ones and pray for them in a special way throughout the month of November by displaying their pictures in the vestibule and their names placed on the alter at every Mass.
