Today's Readings

First Reading (*Proverbs 8:22-31*)

Thus says the wisdom of God: "The Lord possessed me, the beginning of his ways, the forerunner of his prodigies of long ago; from of old I was poured forth, at the first, before the earth. When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no fountains or springs of water; before the mountains were settled into place, before the hills, I was brought forth; while as yet the earth and fields were not made, nor the first clods of the world. "When the Lord established the heavens I was there, when he marked out the vault over the face of the deep; when he made firm the skies above, when he fixed fast the foundations of the earth; when he set for the sea its limit, so that the waters should not transgress his command; then was I beside him as his craftsman, and I was his delight day by day, playing before him all the while, playing on the surface of his earth; and I found delight in the human race."

Psalm (*Psalm 8:4-5, 6-7, 8-9*)

R. O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

When I behold your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars which you set in place, what is man that you should be mindful of him, or the son of man that you should care for him?

R. O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

Second Reading (*Romans 5:1-5*)

Brothers and sisters: Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith to this grace in which we stand, and we boast in hope of the glory of God. Not only that, but we even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character, and proven character, hope, and hope does not disappoint; because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

Gospel (*John 16:12-15*)

Jesus said to his disciples: "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you."

Gospel Reflection

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the basic doctrine of the Christian faith and of Christian life. The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father, the Son is one and the same God. The mission of the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father in the name of the Son (Jn 14:26) and by the Son "from the Father" (Jn 15:26), reveals that the Spirit is one and the same God. "With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified".

It teaches that there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature. St. Cyril explains the Most Holy Trinity using sun as an example: "God the Father is the blazing sun. God the Son is its light and God the Holy Spirit is its heat — but there is only one sun. Another example to understand the Holy Trinity is the three states of water: solid (ice), liquid (water) and gas (vapor). So, there are three Persons in the Holy Trinity but God is One and indivisible."

They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds." The divine Unity is Triune.

"In the relational names of the persons the Father is related to the Son, the Son to the Father, and the Holy Spirit to both. While they are called three persons in view of their relations, we believe that there is only one nature or substance but three distinct persons."

"God has revealed to us three separate functions that are carried out by the Three Persons. He has told us that it is proper to attribute to God the Father the work of Creation, to God the Son the work of Redemption and to God the Holy Spirit the work of Sanctification."

Today, as the Church is publicly proclaiming her faith in the Triune God, we must earnestly pray for the grace that we enter into and live this faith in our daily lives. Our faith in God our Father, his Son and the Spirit must become more living, and operative in our lives.
