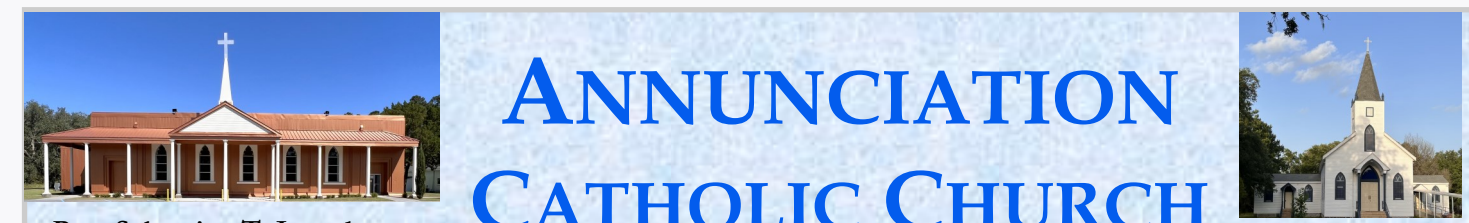

**II Reading: Rom 13:8-10**

Brothers and sisters: Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery; and whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no evil to the neighbor; hence, love is the fulfillment of the law.

**Gospel :Mt 18:15-20**

Jesus said to his disciples: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother. If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, so that every fact may be established on the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If he refuses to listen to them, tell the church. If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector. Amen, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

**Gospel Reflection:**

"If he listens to you, you have won over your brother" (Mt 18:15). Many of us tend to point out the mistakes of others in public, insulting them. In today's Gospel Jesus teaches us that it is wrong to do so. Jesus tells us that we need to follow three steps before we take a decision about an erring person. First, we have to talk to that person one-on-one; if that fails, we have to talk to the same person in the presence of two or three people. If the person who is wrong refuses to accept their words, we have to report it to the church, if he refuses to listen even to the church, then he can be considered as unrelenting and beyond reform. Through this teaching, Jesus is inviting us to be extra-generous while correcting or dealing with an erring person. How do I deal with my brother/sister who prefers to go the wrong way and refuses to change? Am I willing to go the extra mile in bringing back a person who has gone astray or do I condemn him/her? Do I act as "my brother's keeper"?
