#### **TODAY'S READINGS**

#### First Reading (Exodus 34:4b-6,8-9)

Early in the morning Moses went up Mount Sinai as the LORD had commanded him, taking along the two stone tablets. Having come down in a cloud, the LORD stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, "LORD." Thus the LORD passed before him and cried out, "The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Moses at once bowed down to the ground in worship. Then he said, "If I find favor with you, O Lord, do come along in our company. This is indeed a stiff-necked people; yet pardon our wickedness and sins, and receive us as your own."

#### **Second Reading** (2 Corinthians 13:11-13)

Brothers and sisters, rejoice. Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the holy ones greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

#### Gospel (John 3:16-18)

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

#### **Gospel Reflection**

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the basic doctrine of the Christian faith and of Christian life. The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father the Son is one and the same God. The mission of the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father in the name of the Son (Jn 14:26) and by the Son "from the Father" (Jn 15:26), reveals that the Spirit is one and the same God. "With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified" (Nicene

It teaches that there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature. St. Cyril explains the Most Holy Trinity using sun as an example: "God the Father is the blazing sun. God the Son is its light and God the Holy Spirit is its heat — but there is only one sun. Another example to understand the Holy Trinity is the three states of water: solid (ice), liquid (water) and gas (vapor). So, there are three Persons in the Holy Trinity but God is One and indivisible."

They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds." The divine Unity is Triune.

"In the relational names of the persons the Father is related to the Son, the Son to the Father, and the Holy Spirit to both. While they are called three persons in view of their relations, we believe in one nature or substance." That means there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature.

"God has revealed to us three separate functions that are carried out by the Three Persons. He has told us that it is proper to attribute to God the Father the work of Creation, to God the Son the work of Redemption and to God the Holy Spirit the work of Sanctification."

#### Continued

Today, as the Church is publicly proclaiming her faith in the Triune God, we must earnestly pray for the grace that we enter into and live this faith in our daily lives. Our faith in God our Father, his Son and the Spirit must become more living, and operative in our lives.
