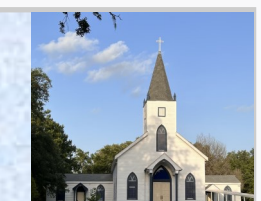

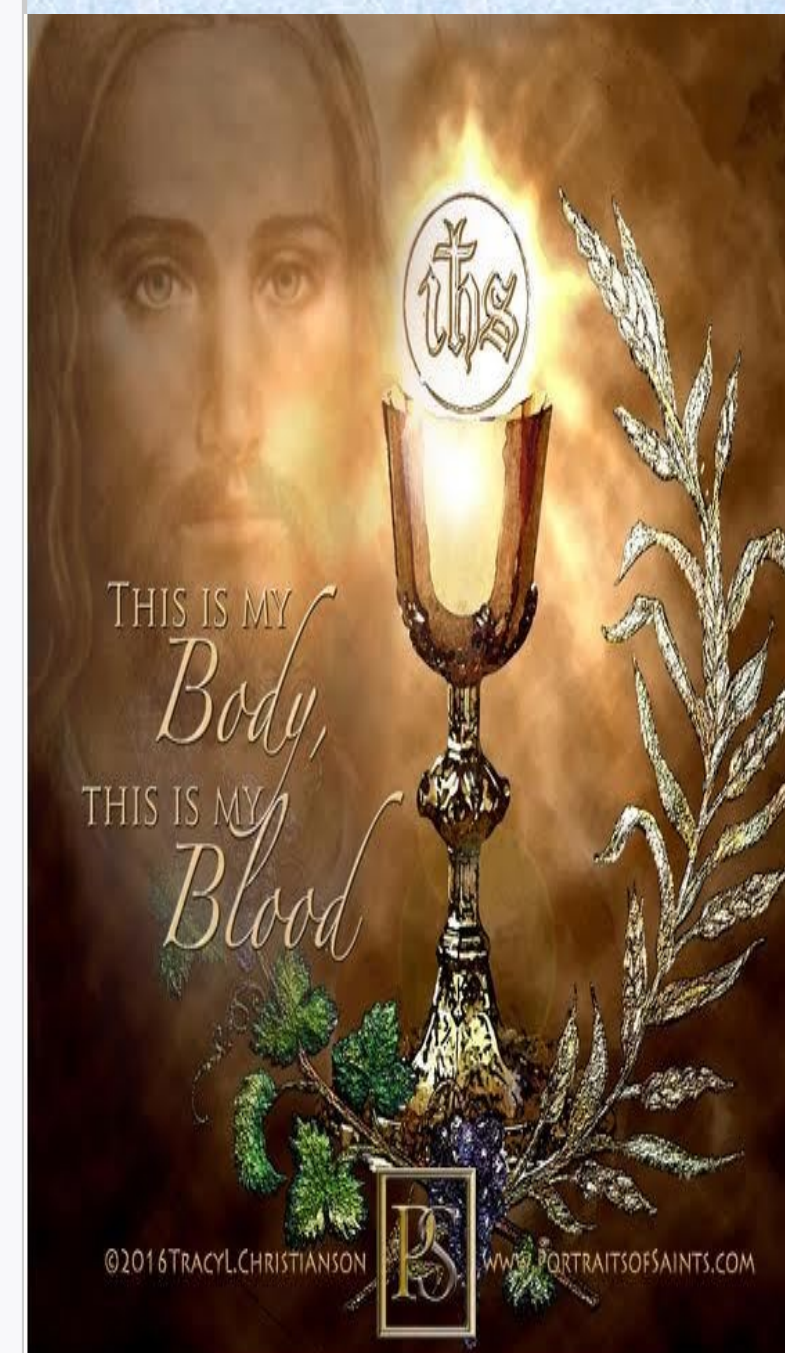

**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading** (Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a)

Moses said to the people: "Remember how for forty years now the LORD, your God, has directed all your journeying in the desert, so as to test you by affliction and find out whether or not it was your intention to keep his commandments. He therefore let you be afflicted with hunger, and then fed you with manna, a food unknown to you and your fathers, in order to show you that not by bread alone does one live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the LORD. "Do not forget the LORD, your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery; who guided you through the vast and terrible desert with its saraph serpents and scorpions, its parched and waterless ground; who brought forth water for you from the flinty rock and fed you in the desert with manna, a food unknown to your fathers."

**Psalm** (147:12-13, 14-15, 19-20)

**R. Praise the Lord, Jerusalem.**

Glorify the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise your God, O Zion. For he has strengthened the bars of your gates; he has blessed your children within you.

He has granted peace in your borders; with the best of wheat he fills you. He sends forth his command to the earth; swiftly runs his word!

**Second Reading** (1 Corinthians 10:16-17)

Brothers and sisters: The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf.

**Gospel (John 6:51-58)**

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day.

For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

**Gospel Reflection**

This Sunday our church celebrates the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known by its Latin name 'Corpus Christi'. It is an opportunity to reflect on the fact that Christ gave us his body and blood for our spiritual sustenance.

The Lord who brought the Israelites out of the land of slavery would feed them with manna in the desert to prove that God would not abandon them to die there. They were also given fresh water from the rock to quench their thirst. Manna in the desert and water from the rock prefigure the Eucharistic body and blood of Christ. Jesus is the living bread that came down from heaven.





Vatican II states that as a sacrifice "the Holy Eucharist is the center and culmination of Christian life" (*Lumen Gentium*, 11). We believe it as the "Real Presence" of Jesus because 1) Jesus promised it after miraculously feeding 5000 people. 2) Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist during his Last Supper and commanded his disciples to repeat it in his memory. 3) He commanded to eat his body and drink his blood to have eternal life. "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day"

We explain the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist by: "transubstantiation" which means that the substance of the bread offered and wine is changed by Consecration to the substance of the risen Jesus' glorified, Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit, and its accidents or appearances (like color, shape, smell, taste etc.), remain the same.

Jesus instituted the Eucharist on his last supper. "Jesus took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is my body." Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." (Matthew 26:26 -28) What we consume is, his transformed body and blood. On hearing it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?" (John 6:60). "From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him" (John 6.66). So, it is very clear to us that Jesus said it in literal sense to eat his body and drink his blood to have eternal life. Otherwise, they would not have quarreled and left Jesus.

The Eucharist is the Sacrament of our union with Jesus. In this Sacrament, Jesus gives us his own Body, broken for us on the cross and his precious Blood poured out for us, in order that our sins may be forgiven.
